

May 18, 2015
Regular Session

The meeting was called to order by Mayor Glenn Wright. . Members present were Mr. Lewis, Mr. Miller, Mrs. Wynn, and Mr. Moore.

Mr. Lewis opened the meeting with a moment of silence.

Mr. Miller made a motion to approve the May 4, 2015 regular session minutes as presented, after a second by Mr. Moore the motion passed 3-0-1 with Mr. Lewis abstaining.

Freddie Evans gave a report on the Water Department. He stated that the replacement of a manhole on Greene Street has been completed and the placement of a rising manhole at Greensboro Elementary has been completed. Pipes at the Foxchase Apartments has been replaced but they are experiencing other problems that are the responsibility of the property owner not the city. Mr. Evans also stated that the he would need to address the water pressure issue in the Industrial Park with the city engineer and the problem at the county jail would need to be addressed by their maintenance department.

Ron and Annette Benneche addressed the Mayor and Council with concerns of their property located in the rear alley at 110 North Main Street and requested to appeal the decision by the Historic Preservation Commission concerning an issued certificate of appropriateness.

City Manager Postell made a recommendation to accept the low bid from American Tank Maintenance in the amount of \$114,379 for the painting and cleaning of the water tank located in downtown. Mr. Miller made a motion to accept the recommendation of the City Manager, after a second y Mrs. Wynn the motion passed 4-0.

Mrs. Wynn made a motion to enter into an agreement with the Greene County Board of Education and purchase a box truck for \$1.00, after a second by Mr. Moore the motion passed 4-0.

A Movie Night in the park has been scheduled for June 20th in Robinson Park at 7:00 pm.

Mr. Landris Thomas, the new CEO for the Boys and Girls Club was present to introduce himself to the Council.

Mr. Miller made a motion to enter into executive session to discuss two legal matters, after a second by Mr. Moore the motion passed 4-0.

No action was taken in executive session. Two legal matters were discussed. Mr. Miller made a motion authorizing Mayor Wright to sign an affidavit regarding executive session, after a second by Mr. Moore the motion passed 4-0.

Mr. Lewis made a motion to adjourn the meeting, after a second by Mr. Moore the motion passed 4-0.

There being no further business Mr. Miller closed the meeting with prayer.
