Regular Session

The meeting was called to order by Mayor Glenn Wright. Members present were Mr. McWhorter, Mrs. Wynn, Mr. Rhodes, and Mr. Miller.

Mrs. Wynn opened the meeting with prayer.

Mr. McWhorter made a motion to approve the October 6, 2014 regular session minutes as presented, after a second by Mr. Miller the motion passed 4-0.

Mr. Freddie Evans gave the Supervisor's report for the gas department in place of Mr. Wendell Matthews. The gas department is in the process of moving the gas regulator at Novelis away from the building to the parking, there have been a few setbacks but otherwise the project is going good. There have been an accumulation of old gas meters from change outs, burned gas parts, old fire hydrants, and an old jetter that all surplus property will be sold as strap.

Mrs. Annalease Green, a member of the Greene County NAACP and chairperson for the Holiday Gala to be held On December 20, 2014 at Festival Hall made a request for a one day Special Event Alcohol Permit where the proceeds will be used for their scholarship program.

Mrs. Wynn made a motion to approve the request from the NAACP for a One Day Special Events Alcohol Permit, after a second by Mr. Miller the motion passed 4-0.

Mr. Miller made a motion to approve a request from the Lake Oconee Delta Sorority for permission to use a city use day to host their Annual fundraising event at Festival Hall on February 7, 2015, after a second by Mr. McWhorter the motion passed 4—0.

Mr. McWhorter made a motion to enter into executive session to discuss 4 pending legal matter, after a second by Mr. Miller the motion passed 4-0.

Mr. Miller made a motion to return to regular session, after a second by Mr. Rhodes motion passed 4-0.

No action was taken in executive session, four pending legal matters were discussed. Mr. McWhorter made a motion to authorize the Mayor to sign an affidavit regarding executive session, after a second by Mr. Miller the motion passed 4-0.

Mr. Miller made a motion to adjourn the meeting, after a second by Mr. McWhorter the motion passed 4-0.
