

April 18, 2016  
Regular Session

The meeting was called to order by Mayor Glenn Wright. Members present were Mr. Moore, Mr. Miller, Mr. McWhorter, and Mrs. Wynn.

Mr. Miller opened the meeting with prayer.

Mr. Miller made a motion to approve the April 4, 2016 regular session minutes, after a second by Mr. McWhorter the motion passed 3-0-1 with Mr. Moore abstaining.

Chief Mapp could not attend the meeting.

City Manager Postell presented the Special Events Application from Winshape Camp. The Youth Minister from the First United Methodist Church was present to discuss details of the camp. The camp will be held June 13<sup>th</sup> -17<sup>th</sup> from 8am -5pm daily with classes being held at both the First Baptist and First United Methodist Churches. Ages will range from 1<sup>st</sup> grade up to the 9<sup>th</sup> grade. There is expected to be at least 150-200 campers per day with 50-60 volunteers. They have requested police security to help with traffic flow also the closure of city streets.

Mr. McWhorter made a motion to approve the special events application and street closure request as presented, after a second by Mrs. Wynn the motion passed 4-0.

City Manager Postell made a recommendation to appoint Ronnie Stovall as the voting delegate and Cindy Carver as alternate for the Municipal Gas Authority Annual Election Meeting which will be held May 20<sup>th</sup>. Mr. Miller made a motion to accept the recommendation of the City Manager, after a second by Mr. Moore the motion passed 4-0.

The drawings to resurface Richland Avenue, Ivy Lane and Brighton Road were presented.

City Attorney Fleming was directed to draft an alcohol ordinance for the sales and licensing of beer, wine, and liquor for Bed and Breakfast Companies and bring your own bottles events.

Mr. Miller made a motion to adjourn the meeting, after a second by Mr. Moore the motion passed 4-0.
