Regular Session

The Greensboro City Council Regular Session Meeting was called to order by Mayor Glenn Wright. Council members present were Ms. Wynn, Mr. McWhorter, Mr. Moore and Mr. Miller.

Mr. McWhorter opened the meeting with prayer.

Mr. Miller made a motion to approve the July 1, 2019 Regular Session Minutes as presented, after a second by Mr. McWhorter the motion passed 4-0.

Street Supervisor Johnny Porter gave a report on the state of the Street department. He discussed mechanical issues with the sweeper as well as the purchase of a new tractor and bush hog.

Mr. Smith arrived at the meeting.

Travis Williamson made a request for a one-day special events beer and wine license for a benefit for the Fire-Fly-Trail to be held at Festival Hall on August 16. Mr. Miller made a motion to approve the license. After a second by Mr. Smith, the motion passed 5-0.

Nicole Chillemi made a request on behalf of Festival Hall for beer and wine sales, August 8, 9, and 10 during the performance of 12 Incompetent jurors, performed by the Lake Country Players. Mr. McWhorter made a motion to approve the license, after a second by Mr. Miller, the motion passed 5-0.

Rick Zeier Presented for a second reading the Ordinance to annex the property located at 2951 Lake Oconee Parkway, parcel 052000021A, 052000021B, 052000021D. Mr. McWhorter made a motion to annex the property. After a second by Mr. Miller, the motion passed 5-0.

The City Manager presented the recommendation to the full Council on Changing Non-FLSA employees compensatory time to expire after one month of being acquired. Mr. McWhorter made a motion to approve changes as presented, after a second by Ms. Wynn, the Resolution was passed 5-0.

City Attorney Barry Fleming presented to the Council for a first reading to allow the Courts to euthanize vicious animals after any incident. Mr. McWhorter made a motion at accept the first reading. After a second by Mr. Smith, the motion passed 5-0.

City Attorney Barry Fleming presented a map describing an old right of way at the end of 5th street to be abandoned. Mr. Moore made a motion to proceed with the abandonment. After a second by Ms. Wynn, the motion passed 5-0.

Mr. Zeier gave the Council an update on building permits and the status of several enforcement actions he is involved with around the City.
