

April 20, 2015  
Regular Session

The meeting was called to order by Mayor Glenn Wright. Members present were Mr. McWhorter, Mr. Miller, Mrs. Wynn, and Mr. Moore.

Mr. Miller opened the meeting with prayer.

Mr. Miller made a motion to approve the April 6, 2015 regular session minutes as presented. After a second by Mr. Moore the motion passed 4-0.

Mr. Lewis arrives to meeting.

Chief Mapp introduced Demone Clark, a new officer with the department and gave an update on the Police Department. He presented several reports and discussed with the Council.

Mr. Lester Alexander made a request to have speed breakers placed along Planning Mill Road and provided a petition from several residents living in the area. City Manager Postell was directed to evaluate the situation to either place speed limit signs or speed breakers in the area.

The second reading of the Fire Pits Ordinance was completed. Mr. McWhorter made a motion to approve the ordinance as presented, after a second by Mr. Miller the motion passed 5-0.

The second reading of the ordinance adopting and enacting a new code for the City of Greensboro was completed. Mrs. Wynn made a motion to approve the ordinance as presented, after a second by Mr. Lewis the motion passed 5-0.

An issue with school buses traveling on West Richland Avenue was brought to the attention of the Mayor and Council and discussed. It was decided that any improvements to West Richland Avenue would be placed on a priority list and completed whenever funds become available.

Mrs. Lilli Hill, operator, of the Adult Daycare Center at 504 Martin Luther King Jr Drive has requested an additional letter from the city because she feels the letter that she was previously given was not sufficient. She would like for the letter to include a statement that she can continue to legally operate for the next 90 days. City Attorney Fleming advised the Mayor and Council that it would not be possible to issue another letter to include that statement since she is not zoned properly to continue operation of the Adult Daycare Center, but she would need to submit to the Department of Community Health that she is making an effort to come into compliance with the city ordinance.

Mr. James Griggs questioned the Mayor and Council since his boarding house was grandfathered could the Adult Daycare Center also be grandfathered in. The Zoning Administrator stated that Mrs. Hill's Adult Daycare Center now requires a state license because of new regulations from the Department of Community Health.

The Zoning Administrator made a recommendation to appoint Russell Wall to the Planning and Zoning Board to fill the unexpired term of Vincent Lewis. Mr. Miller made a motion to accept the recommendation of the Zoning Administrator, after a second by Mrs. Wynn the motion passed 5-0.

Mr. McWhorter made a motion to enter into executive session to discuss two pending legal matters, after a second by Mr. Miller the motion passed 5-0.

Mr. Miller made a motion to return to regular session, after a second by Mr. Moore the motion passed 5-0.
