Mr. Miller made a motion to reappoint Fleming & Nelson as the City Attorney, after a second by Mr. McWhorter the motion passed 5-0.

Mr. Moore made a motion to reappoint Dexter Wimbish as the Municipal Court Judge, after a second by Mr. Miller the motion passed 5-0.
