Regular Session

The Greensboro City Council meeting was called to order by Mayor Glenn Wright. Members present were Mr. Miller, Mr. Smith, MS. Wynn, Mr. McWhorter, and Mr. Moore.

Mayor Wright opened the meeting with prayer.

Mr. McWhorter made a motion to approve the June 18, 2018 regular session minutes as presented, after a second by Mr. Moore the motion passed 5-0.

Mr. Miller made a motion to approve the June 18, 2018 executive session minutes as presented, after a second by Mr. McWhorter the motion passed 5-0.

Cail Hammons and Kendrick Ward gave a mid- year report for the Main Street Program. They addressed the 4 points to being a Main Street which are Economic Restructuring, Design, Organization, and Promotion.

Economic Restructuring-two new businesses were gained in downtown, applications for the CHIP grant have been received and reviewed and are awaiting final approval.

Design-Mary Leila Lofts and Oconee Brewing Company were recognized by the Georgia Trust for Historic Preservation in April for Excellence in Historic Rehabilitation.

Organization- Greensboro's 2017 Program Assessment was approved by the Office of Downtown Development. Greensboro is a certified National Trust Main Street and a Georgia Exceptional Main Street for 2018.

Promotion- Marketing efforts include event rack card, downtown brochure update, a new historic walking tour brochure is currently under development, participation in Treasures along I-20, Georgia's Lake Country and Traditions Highway. Print Advertisement in Lake Oconee Living, Oconee the Magazine, and the 2018 Georgia State Travel Guide.

Mr. McWhorter made a motion to approve the road closure request as presented for the Back 2 School Bash which will be held on July 21 in downtown, after a second by Mr. Miller the motion passed 5-0.

Mr. McWhorter made a motion to extend the 5 Year Plan for an additional 5 years which was last updated in 2017, after a second by Mr. Miller the motion passed 5-0.
