Regular Session

The Greensboro City Council meeting was called to order by Mayor Glenn Wright. Council Members present were Mr. McWhorter, Mr. Smith, Mr. Miller, Mr. Wynn, and Mr. Moore.

Mr. Smith opened the meeting with prayer.

Mr. McWhorter made a motion to approve the July 16, 2018 regular session minutes as presented, after a second by Mr. Miller the motion passed 5-0.

Mr. Miller made a motion to approve the July 16, 2018 executive session minutes as presented, after a second by Mr. McWhorter the motion passed 5-0.

Chief Bashore gave an update on the Fire Department. He stated that the department is running smoothly there are not any issues to report at this time, but the department is in need of volunteers.

Mr. Moore made a motion to accept the recommendation of City Manager Postell and approve the request by Sheelander Korukonda for a beer and wine license for Hilltop Foodmart located at 2017 Martin Luther King Jr. Drive, after a second by Mr. McWhorter the motion passed 5-0.

Mr. Rick Plymale could not attend the meeting.

Mr. Miller made a motion to approve the resolution reaffirming the designation of Urban Redevelopment Powers within the Greensboro Downtown Development Authority, after a second by Mr. McWhorter the motion passed 5-0.

Mr. Smith made a motion to approve the resolution supporting the application to the Georgia Department of Community Affairs for the designation of a Rural Zone within Greensboro, after a second by Mr. McWhorter the motion passed 5-0.

Mr. Miller made a motion to accept the Streetscape Contract as presented and move forward with the project, after a second by Mr. Moore the motion passed 5-0.

Mr. McWhorter made a motion authorizing Cail Hammons to move forward with the Transportation Alternative Program Grant application and authorize Mayor Wright and City Manager Postell to sign all grant documents, after a second by Ms. Wyn the motion passed 5-0.

City Manager Postell made a motion to appoint Captain Rodricus Monford as the interim Chief of Police. Mr. Moore recused himself from any discussion or voting. Mr. Miller made a motion to accept the recommendation from the City Manager, after a second by Mr. McWhorter the motion passed 3-1-1 with Mr. Smith voting against and Mr. Moore abstaining.

The first reading of the Soil Erosion Ordinance was done.
