

August 21, 2017
Regular Session

The Regular Session of the Greensboro City Council was called to order by Mayor Glenn Wright. Council Members present were Mr. McWhorter, Ms. Wynn, Mr. Miller, and Mr. Moore,

Mr. Miller opened the meeting with prayer.

Mr. McWhorter made a motion to approve the August 8, 2017 regular session minutes as presented, after a second by Mr. Miller the motion passed 4-0.

Mr. Lewis arrived at the meeting.

Mr. Miller made a motion to approve the August 8, 2017 executive session minutes as presented, after a second by Mr. McWhorter the motion passed 5-0.

Chief Mapp was present to report on the status of the Police Department. He stated that the day to day operation of the department is good at this time. He also reported that a Neighborhood Watch meeting was held on August 14 but no citizens attended, and a job fair with the Juvenile Justice System was held at the department and had a very good turnout. Chief Mapp answered questions from the council. Mr. Moore urged the department to continue their efforts with the Neighborhood Watch Program and thanked the Department for the services that they are providing.

James Bay Wright was present to address the council on community concerns and he questioned each council member on their biggest concerns for the city. Each council member individually stated that the citizens are their primary concern. James Bay further stated that the community has an issue with the county police coming into the city limits to patrol and feels that there is a good relationship between the city police and the community. He also asked the council about placing a swimming pool and basketball goals to give the kids something positive to do. City Attorney Nelson stated that the city would have to look further into the request.

The second reading of the ordinance amending Chapter 107 Article 1 Historic Preservation was done. Mr. Miller made a motion to adopt the ordinance as presented after a second by Mr. Moore the motion passed 5-0.

The second reading of the ordinance amending Article IV Alcoholic Beverages was done. Mr. McWhorter made a motion to adopt the ordinance as presented, after a second by Mr. Lewis the motion passed 5-0.

Mr. Miller made a motion to enter into an Intergovernmental Agreement with Greene County for Library and Recreation Services, after a second by Mr. McWhorter the motion 4-1 with Mr. Moore voting against.

Mr. Miller made a motion to adjourn the meeting, after a second by Mr. Lewis the motion passed 5-0.
