Regular Session

The Regular Session of the Greensboro City Council was called to order by Mayor Glenn Wright. Members present were Mr. McWhorter, Mr. Smith, Mr. Miller, Ms. Wynn and Mr. Moore.

Ms. Wynn opened the meeting with prayer.

Mr. Moore made a motion to approve the August 20, 2018 Regular Session Minutes as presented, after a second by Mr. Miller the motion passed 5-0.

Mr. Miller made a motion to approve the August 20, 2018 Executive Session Minutes as presented with corrections to the correct city attorney that was present, after a second by Mr. McWhorter the motion passed 5-0.

Brenda Burke updated the Council on the operations of the Waste Water Treatment Plant. The old pumps have been replaced and all testing have been completed. All operators have been scheduled for training next month. The plant is operating good and there are not at problems to report.

Rodricus Monford introduced Nicolas Hobbs, a new officer with the Police Department.

The approval for a beer and wine license for the Dollar General Store was tabled until the Store Manager can be present.

City Manager Postell made a recommendation to grant a beer and wine license to Allan Bellinger for the Thai Vegan Restaurant located at 109 North Main street. Mr. Miller made a motion to approve the recommendation from the City Manager, after a second by Ms. Wynn the motion passed 5-0.

Mr. McWhorter made a motion authorizing Mayor Wright to sign new IGA with Greene County for Solid Waste,, Recreation, Library, and E-911 Dispatch, after a second by Mr. Miller the motion passed 5-0
