

September 5, 2017
Regular Session

The Regular Session of the Greensboro City Council was called to order by Mayor Glenn Wright. Council members present were Mr. McWhorter, Mr. Miller, Ms. Wynn, and Mr. Moore.

Mr. Moore opened the meeting with prayer.

Mr. McWhorter made a motion to approve the August 21, 2017 Regular Session Minutes as presented, after a second by Ms. Wynn the motion passed 4-0.

Mr. Miller made a motion to approve the August 21, 2017 Executive Session Minutes as presented, after a second by Mr. Moore the motion passed 4-0.

Brenda Burke gave an update on the Sewer Plant. The grid chambers and LAS pump has been repaired. The lift station at Home Depot has been replaced. All WET testing have been approved and passed. The clean up of the pond on Highway 15 will need to take place soon. The city will need to find a place to dispose of the sludge. The permit for the plant has been submitted and will not have to be submitted again for 4 years. Manpower is good at this time but will eventually need to hire 1 fulltime and 1 part time employee.

Mr. McWhorter made a motion to approve the street closure request from the Greene County High School to close streets for the Annual Homecoming Parade to be held on September 28 from 4:30 to 5:30, after a second by Ms. Wynn the motion passed 4-0.

Mr. Miller made a motion to approve the request from the Greene County Chamber of Commerce for a special events beer and wine permit for the Taste and Jam to be held October 23, after a second by Mr. McWhorter the motion passed 4-0.

The introduction of the budget for FY 2018 was done.
