Regular Session

The Regular Session of the Greensboro City Council was called to order by Mayor Glenn Wright. Members present were Mr. McWhorter, Mr. Miller, Mr. Moore, Mr. Lewis, and Ms. Wynn.

Mr. McWhorter opened the meeting with prayer

Mr. Miller made a motion to approve the September 5, 2017 Regular Session minutes as presented, after a second by Mr. McWhorter the motion passed 4-0-1 with Mr. Lewis abstaining.

Mr. Miller made a motion to approve the September 5, 2017 Executive Session Minutes as presented, after a second by Mr. Moore the motion passed 4-0-1 with Mr. Lewis abstaining.

Freddie Evans gave an update on the Water Department and discussed two major water leaks that were repaired over the weekend. Mr. Evans presented a sample billing to each council member and explained the new billing process for the new meter reading system. The installation of all gas meters should be completed within six weeks. He also discussed the Disaster plan for the County which is updated every four years.

Mamie Hillman requested to have three banners placed on Northeast Street in support of African American Heritage. The council is in support of the request and directed Ms. Hillman to contact City Manager Postell and Kendrick Ward to come up with the pricing for the banners and the installation.
