Regular Session

The Regular Session of the Greensboro City Council was called to order by Mayor Glenn Wright. Members present were Mr. McWhorter, Ms. Wynn, Mr. Moore, and Mr. Lewis.

Mayor Wright opened the meeting with prayer.

Mr. Moore made a motion to approve the July 3, 2017 Regular Session Minutes as presented, after a second by Mr. McWhorter the motion passed 4-0.

They also discussed the Made in the shade grant which allows downtown businesses to purchase awnings at a discount from leftover façade grant funds.

Mr. Lewis made a motion to approve the street closure request to close downtown streets for the Annual Cruise In September 16 and The Lighting of the Tree December 1 as presented, after a second by Ms. Wynn the motion passed 4-0.
