

May 1, 2017  
Regular Session

The Regular Session of the Greensboro City Council was called to order by Mayor Glenn Wright. Members present were Mr. Moore, Mr. McWhorter, Mr. Miller, Ms. Wynn, and Mr. Lewis.

Mr. Moore opened the meeting with prayer.

Mr. Miller made a motion to approve the April 17, 2017 regular session minutes as presented, after a second by Mr. Miller the motion passed 4-0-1 with Mr. Lewis abstaining.

Brenda Burke gave a report on the Waste Water Treatment Plant. She stated that all reports had been submitted. Manpower is good for now, but will eventually need an additional employee

Mr. Lewis made a motion to accept the City Manager's recommendation and allow the Greensboro First United Methodist Church to move forward with striping crosswalks on Broad and West Streets, after a second by Mrs. Wynn the motion passed 5-0.

Kendrick Ward gave a presentation on playground equipment for the Robinson Park. She presented bids from Eco Play which uses recycled milk jugs and presented a bid of \$38,775.00 and KorKat which uses powder coated metal and includes a dog park presented a bid for \$37,694. Equipment will be paid for with SPLOST funds. Mr. Miller made a motion to accept the bid from KorKat for playground equipment, after a second by Mr. McWhorter the motion passed 5-0.

Mr. Lewis made a motion to accept the street closure request as presented and close the listed streets for Pickin on the Green to be held June 16, and Back to School Bash to be held August 5, after a second by Ms. Wynn the motion passed 5-0.

Mr. Miller made a motion to appoint Katy Dalagle to the Historic Preservation Commission to fill the seat of Joel McCray, after a second by Mr. McWhorter the motion passed 5-0.

The first reading of the Jake Braking Ordinance was done.

The 2017 Chip Agreement was tabled until next meeting.

Mr. Moore made a motion to close Greene Street to the bridge and North Street for the Lake Country Brewing's Grand Opening, after a second by Mr. McWhorter the motion passed 5-0.
