Regular Session

Chief Bashore gave a report on the Fire Department. The call volume for emergency calls have dropped since the weather has turned cool. A mock disaster drill with Tri-County Gas has been scheduled for November 11th. Chief Bashore will begin accepting applications for new volunteers for the department in the next few weeks. The department is running good at this time, most of the maintenance on the building is done in-house.
