Regular Session

The meeting was called to order by Mayor Glenn Wright. Members present were Mr. McWhorter, Mr. Miller, Mrs. Wynn, and Mr. Moore.

Mr. Moore opened the meeting with prayer.

Mr. Moore made a motion to approve the December 15, 2014 regular session minutes as presented with correction to the spelling of Johnny Lewis' name, after a second by Mr. McWhorter the motion passed 4-0.

Mr. Miller made a motion to approve December 15, 2014 Executive Session 1 minutes as presented, after a second by Mr. McWhorter the motion passed 4-0.

Mr. Moore made a motion to approve December 15, 2014 Executive Session 2 minutes as presented, after a second by Mr. Miller the motion passed 4-0.

Freddie Evans gave a report on the Water Department. All repairs and water leaks are being made daily as needed. The sewer spill near the Elementary School did not cause any contamination or health risk, the spill was within the EPD regulation for spills. A camera system will be set up on North Spring Street to check for blockages and collapsed pipes. The number of rereads for water bills have decreased since August. Manpower at this time is good as well as the equipment.

A second reading of the ordinance amending Article XI: Special Provisions of the Zoning Ordinance was done. Mr. Moore made a motion to approve the ordinance as presented, after a second by Mr. Miller the motion passed 4-0.

Mr. McWhorter made a motion to appoint Chris Bragg to the Greene County Development Authority to replace Jim Hudson, after a second by Mrs. Wynn the motion passed 4-0.

Mr. Miller made a motion to adjourn the meeting, after a second by Mr. Moore the motion passed 4-0.
